The cross country season ended last Saturday at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington for area runners.

In the Single A meet:

The men's race showcased fast running from Campbellsville's Michael Rafferty. Rafferty finished 30th in race. Derrick Troxell led Green County's Cross country team finished eleventh overall in the team meet. Other notable finishes include Glasgow's Zack Wheeler placing 129th, Joseph Quick of Monroe County finishing 155th and Cumberland County's Corey Williams finishing 160th.
