BUSH SAYS SHE IS A HANDS ON OWNER AND ADMITS THE STAFF SOMETIMES IS SURPRISED TO SEE SOME OF THE TASKS SHE UNDERTAKES.

"Most people cannot believe an owner will jump in and paint and mop

floors and do whatever but I believe I am not too good to do any job at

that nursing home."

BUSH SAYS SHE HOPES THERE'S A LESSON IN HER WILLINGNESS TO JUMP IN AND DO WHATEVER JOB NEEDS DOING.

"I want them to see that I am just like they are. I am just another person.

I am no better than they are. And I am just tickled to death to be there to

do whatever I can for the staff and the residents at Glenview."
