The council did pass an ordinance that would add an element to the Glasgow Alternative Transportation Endeavor, also known as G.A.T.E.. This will help the city acquire funding for alternative ways for both citizens and tourists to travel by alternative green methods throughout Glasgow and surrounding Barren County communities. Some of that funding would come from state and federal grants.
