Officer Elmore Assisted At The Scene And Grabbed Mclaughin By The Shirt He Began To Pull Away Using The Door Frame. While Apprehending Mclaughin He Resisted And Was Pushed To The Ground By Officers. Officer Elmore Stated He Was Going To Jail And The Above Continued To Resist When Being Handcuffed. Mclaughin Was Charged With Resisting Arrest And Disorderly Conduct 2nd Degree. He Was Lodged In The Barren County Jail.
