

WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON WRECK CLOSSES HAPPY VALLEY ROAD

Traffic was snarled yesterday afternoon on the Happy Valley Road near Walmart after a passenger vehicle and a Tractor Trailer Rig collided, closing the roadway for about an hour and a half. Amanda Bechard of 220 Carden Road told Police she was travelling west in her 2008 Chevy Equinox between Reynolds Road and Walmart and felt light headed. The next thing she knew she was involved in an accident. The driver Peterbuilt tractor trailer, Daniel F. Cottrell of Louisville told police he was traveling east on Highway 90 near Walmart when he saw the Equinox cross the center land, strike a guard rail and collided with the vehicle. A witness at the scene confirmed Cottrell's account of the accident. Amanda Bechard was taken to T.J.Samson Hospital for treatment of non life threatening injuries. The road was closed because of the accident scene took up a large area of the roadway, and was reopened at 2:55pm. Glasgow Police officer Tammy Britt was the lead investigating officer.
