

WARREN COUNTY MAN HELD GIRLFRIEND AT KNIFE-POINT

On Monday Warren County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Hwy 185, after receiving a 911 call from Brittany Furlong stating she was being held against her will, at knife-point, in her vehicle. Furlong told Deputies her boyfriend, Joshua Russell, had punched her in the face, held a knife to her throat, arm and stomach and threatened to cut her if she stopped driving. Upon location of the vehicle, Deputies conducted a traffic stop and Russell was immediately taken into custody without incident. A knife was found in Russell's pocket and victim had visible marks on her body. The couple's two children, a 22 month old and a 4 month old were in the vehicle during this incident. Russell was charged with Assault 4th Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment 1st Degree and Wanton Endangerment 1

Degree and taken to the Warren County Regional Jail.
