

GPD / KSP ARREST OF A HIT AND RUN

On Thursday afternoon, Glasgow Police Officers received a complaint of a hit and run involving a red mustang. As officers searched the area for the vehicle, they were notified that the Kentucky State Police had the vehicle pulled over for a traffic stop.
