

REWARD INCREASED FOR MISSING KROGER EMPLOYEE

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) - A reward for information leading to an arrest and conviction in the death of a Kroger employee has increased to \$25,000. Indian Hills Mayor Tom Eifler has agreed to contribute \$5,000 to the reward fund. St. Matthews Police Officer Dennis McDonald told WAVE-TV in Louisville that the funds will be added to the existing \$20,000 reward put up by Kroger and others for information about the slaying of 34-year-old Jack Combs.
