A Leitchfield Kentucky man was sentenced, this month, to ten years in prison, followed by ten years of supervised release. 29 year old Michael Brandon Thompson plead guilty in United States District Court, to violating federal child pornography laws between July and September of 2011.

According to the Affidavit attached to a Criminal Complaint, a detective with the Colorado Springs Police Department, utilized the peer-to-peer file sharing network downloaded several password-protected files from Thompson.

During the download, the detective was able to preview approximately 300 video files containing images of child pornography.

Kentucky State Police were notified, and executed a search warrant on Thompson's home and seized computer equipment and storage devices for digital media.

A forensic examination of those items revealed tens of thousands of videos and still images of child pornography, including infants.
