

## West Central Kentucky Gas Prices Steady

West Central Kentucky gas prices stayed about the same at \$3.64 a gallon, according

to AAA East Central.

## On the National Front

As we approach the end of the first full month of the 2014 summer driving season, the national price for regular unleaded gasoline is \$3.68 per gallon, which is the highest price for early summer in six years. The average price at the pump has increased for 13 consecutive days for a total of four cents per gallon, narrowing the gap between the current retail price and the 2014 peak of \$3.70 per gallon reached on April 28. Today's average is two cents more than one week ago and motorists are paying 11 cents more per gallon than a year ago.

Locally, Bowling Green and Elizabethtown are both at an average of \$3.50 per gallon. That is not the same across the state as Paducah is at \$3.62, Owensboro is at \$3.70 and Louisville motorists are paying an average of \$3.90 per gallon.
